

UNIFORM POLICY

Purpose

The uniform policy at Mandalika Intercultural School (MIS) aims to promote equality among students, reduce distractions, and create a cohesive school identity. We embrace diversity and encourage respect for cultural backgrounds while maintaining a standard of presentation.

Uniform Guidelines

1. General Uniform Requirements:

- All students are required to wear the designated school uniform during school hours and at official school events.
- Uniforms should be clean, well-maintained, and fit properly.

2. Daily Uniform Components:

Early Years Students:

- Blue MIS Early Years T shirt

Primary Boys:

- White collared MIS T shirt
- Navy blue MIS shorts or MIS PE shorts.
- Closed-toe shoes or sandals with heel strap and two foot straps.

Primary Girls:

- White collared MIS T shirt
- Navy blue MIS skirt or skort or MIS PE shorts
- Closed-toe shoes or sandals with heel strap and two foot straps.

Hybrid Program Students

- Same uniform as primary students

3. Physical Education (PE) Uniform:

- MIS PE shirt
- MIS PE shorts
- Athletic shoes

4. Special Occasions:

- On designated special occasions or events, communicated in advance by the school, students may be allowed to wear themed or casual attire. This attire should be respectful and appropriate for a school setting.

5. Outerwear:

- Students may wear appropriate outerwear (such as jackets or sweaters) in solid colors (navy blue, black, or white) while in school.
- Hooded sweatshirts should not have large logos or graphics to maintain a professional appearance.

6. Jewelry and Accessories:

- Jewelry should be modest and not pose a risk during school activities.
- Hair accessories should complement the uniform and not be overly distracting (e.g., headbands, clips in school colors).

7. Personal Grooming:

- Students are expected to maintain proper personal hygiene.
- Hair should be neatly styled and of a natural color. Extreme hairstyles (e.g., mohawks, unnatural colors) are discouraged.

8. Non-Compliance:

- Students not in compliance with the uniform policy may be asked to change into appropriate attire or may face disciplinary action.
- Parents will be notified if their child consistently fails to adhere to uniform requirements.
