

CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) POLICY

Rationale

Mandalika Intercultural School (MIS) needs to ensure that all stakeholders understand that the school has a widespread closed-circuit television (CCTV) system and the purposes for which it is used.

Purpose:

MIS is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for its students, staff, and visitors. This CCTV policy outlines the use of Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras on the school premises to support this commitment.

Scope:

This policy applies to all students, staff, visitors, and contractors on MIS premises.

Objectives:

- 1. To deter and detect unauthorized access, theft, vandalism, and other security breaches.
- 2. To provide evidence in the event of an incident or investigation.
- 3. To support the health and safety of students, staff, and visitors.
- 4. To monitor and maintain the security of school premises and assets.

CCTV Camera Locations:

CCTV cameras will be installed in strategic locations around the school premises, including:

- Entrances and exits
- Hallways and corridors
- Library and sickbay
- Playgrounds and outdoor areas
- Administrative offices

Data Protection:

- 1. CCTV footage will be stored securely on a dedicated server.
- 2. Access to CCTV footage will be restricted to authorized personnel only.
- 3. CCTV footage will be retained for a maximum of 30 days.
- 4. CCTV footage will be deleted or destroyed at the end of the retention period.

Access to CCTV Footage:

- 1. Authorized personnel may access CCTV footage for legitimate purposes, such as investigating an incident or monitoring school security.
- 2. Requests for access to CCTV footage must be made in writing to the School Administrator.
- 3. The School Administrator will review and approve or deny requests for access to CCTV footage.

Notification:

- 1. Clear signage will be displayed at entrances and other strategic locations to notify individuals that CCTV cameras are in use.
- 2. This CCTV policy will be communicated to students, staff, and visitors through the school's website, newsletters, and other communication channels.
